ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORD. NO. 1978-42 ESTABLISHING A COUNTY MUSEUM
AND MUSEUM COMMISSION FOR CRITTENDEN COUNTY, ARKANSAS

Whereas, pursuant to Act 247 of Acts of Arkansas of 1977, the Crittenden County Quorum Court created a county museum and museum commission for Crittenden County, Arkansas by Ord. No. 1978-42; and

Whereas such ordinance directed that such museum was to be under the direction of the Crittenden County Museum Commission; and

Whereas such ordinance set the number of commissioners to be seven members; and

Whereas the county museum is located in Earle, Arkansas; and

Whereas interested persons from such community have requested that the county museum commission be expanded to up to twelve members;

Now therefore be it enacted by the Quorum Court of Crittenden County, Arkansas:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ord. No. 1978-42 is deleted and the following is inserted in its place: The county museum shall be under the direct management and control of Crittenden County Museum Commission, which shall consist of nine members, which is the maximum number of commissioners allowed by state law in Arkansas Code Annotated § 13-5-502(a)(1), to be appointed by the Crittenden County Judge, subject to confirmation and approval of the Crittenden County Quorum Court.

Section 2. At the time of appointment, pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated § 13-5-502(b)(1), County Judge shall specify the respective term of the nine persons appointed to the Crittenden County Museum Commission as follows: the first three members appointed terms shall expire on January 1 of the year next following the appointment of each such member and the remaining 6 members shall be appointed in such manner that their terms shall respectively expire on January 1 of each year thereafter for six years until all such remaining member terms have expired. Replacement for expired members and vacancy terms shall be made in accordance with Arkansas Code Annotated § 13-5-502(b)(2) and (c).

Section 3. The provisions of Ord. No. 1978-42 not in specific conflict herewith shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. It having been found and determined by the Quorum Court of Crittenden County, Arkansas that there is an urgent need to expand the museum commission from seven to nine members to

properly manage the county museum, therefor an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, and well-being for the citizens of Crittenden County, Arkansas shall be in full force and effect from its date of passage and approval.
